

## Words to Students

1. Study for the sake of assimilating and applying knowledge. It is much easier this way than forcing yourself to memorize.
2. Be consistent, set aside time every day to study. Set up a realistic timetable to study and stick to it. Time management is very important.
3. "All study and no play makes Jack a dull boy." So set aside time for play too (after you have studied). Regular and moderate exercises reduce stress by relaxing tensed muscles. Quickest and the most effective way of eliminating stress is to shut down your eyes and take deep breaths.
4. If you are not clear about a topic, ask your teachers, parents or friends. Clear whatever doubt you may have about the topic as soon as possible. Do not be afraid to ask.
5. Be positive. Treat each failure as a learning experience, a stepping stone to a higher ground. Thomas Edison failed many times before he invented the light bulb.
6. Write your own notes. Summarize your teacher's notes. Summarize the textbook. Writing practice should be done by solving different questions.
7. Eat proper meals and drink lots of water. A balanced diet will boost energy success to 99% and 1% intelligence.
8. To make sure that you have understood something thoroughly use these tricks:
  - a) Pretend that you are explaining the lesson to another; see if you can do it well.
  - b) Make yourself your own teacher and question yourself and answer honestly (don't cheat) Make a daily time table for your study.( Time table can be made with different subjects in the order of difficulty the most difficult one being the first). In this way you will learn to be a person of regular habits, the most valuable asset in your life.
- 9) Apply what you learn to your daily life. Believe in yourself and prepare well.
- 10) Students may also practice from the sample Question papers brought out by the CBSE, Marking Schemes performance analysis which analyses common mistakes committed by the students and provides remedial measures.
- 11) YOU CAN DO IT! Never fear exams, avoid panic and most important, do not worry about your results. Give your best shots and move over.



Science and Innovation Fair 2016 – Northern region (07.05.2016)





*Vedic Mathematics* is the name given to the ancient system of Indian *Mathematics* which was rediscovered from the *Vedas* between 1911 and 1918 by Sri Bharati Krisna Tirthaji (1884-1960). According to his research all of *mathematics* is based on sixteen Sutras, or word-formulae.

The following are the advantages of teaching Vedic Mathematics:

- i) Mathematics, derived from the Veda, provides one line, mental and superfast methods along with quick cross checking systems.
- ii) Vedic Mathematics converts a tedious subject into a playful and blissful one which students learn with smiles.
- iii) Vedic Mathematics offers a new and entirely different approach to the study of Mathematics based on pattern recognition. It allows for constant expression of a student's creativity, and is found to be easier to learn.
- iv) In this system, for any problem, there is always one general technique applicable to all cases and also a number of special pattern problems. The element of choice and flexibility at each stage keeps the mind lively and alert to develop clarity of thought and intuition, and thereby a holistic development of the human brain automatically takes place.
- v) Vedic Mathematics with its special features has the inbuilt potential to solve the psychological problem of Mathematics - anxiety.






# Kids Planet Activities



# Important Awards and their Fields

## List of all Important Awards and their Fields

- 1. Bharat Ratna** – The award was given for outstanding achievements in the **arts, literature, science and public services** but the government expanded the criteria to include “**any field of human endeavour**”. The number of annual awards is restricted to a maximum of three in a particular year.
- 2. Padma Awards** – **Padma Vibhushan, Padma Bhushan and Padma Shri** awards are for **exceptional and distinguished service in any field** including service rendered by Government servants.
- 3. Gallantry Awards** – **Param Vir Chakra (PVC), Ashok Chakra, Shaurya Chakra** are given for appreciating the **brave and gallant**.
- 4. Nobel Prize** – The Nobel Prize is widely regarded as the most prestigious award available in the fields of **literature, medicine, physics, chemistry, peace, and economics**.
- 5. Booker Prize** – **Literature**  
It is an annual award for the best original novel, written in the English language, and published in the UK literary award.
- 6. Vyas Samman** – **Literature**  
Vyas Samman is awarded annually by the K.K. Birla Foundation in recognition of the Hindi literary work published in past 10 years.
- 7. Moorti Devi Award** – **Literature**  
The Moortidevi Award is an annual literary award in India presented by the Bharatiya Jnanpith organization for a work which emphasizes Indian philosophy and culture.
- 8. Saraswati Samman** – **Literature**  
The award was instituted in 1991 by the K. K. Birla Foundation. It is an annual award given for outstanding prose or poetry literary works in any 22 Indian languages.
- 9. Jnanpith award** – **Literature**  
The award was instituted in 1961 and it is presented by the Bharatiya Jnanpith, a trust founded by the Sahu Jain family, the publishers of the newspaper The Times of India. It is an annual award given for outstanding prose or poetry literary works in any 22 Indian languages.
- 10. Bihari Puraskar** – **Literature**  
Bihari Puraskar is a literary award instituted by K. K. Birla Foundation. The award is named after the famous Hindi poet Bihari and is awarded to an outstanding work published in Hindi or Rajasthani by a Rajasthani writer.
- 11. The Oscar/Academy Awards** – **Films**  
This is an annual American awards ceremony honoring cinematic achievements in the film industry.
- 12. Dadasaheb Phalke Award** – **Cinema/Films**  
The Dadasaheb Phalke Award is India’s highest award in cinema. It is presented annually at the National Film Awards ceremony by the Directorate of Film Festivals, an organisation set up by the Ministry of Information and Broadcasting.
- 13. Arjuna Award** – outstanding performance from the sports persons in **sports and games**.  
The Government has modified the format of Arjuna Award very recently and as per the revised schematic guidelines a sports person must have very good consistent performances for the previous 3 years at the international level to be considered as eligible for the Award.
- 14. Dronacharya Award** – **Eminent coaches of any particular sport**  
The award is named after the very famous archery coach, mentioned in the epic of India known as the Mahabharata. This very award is not related with the sports persons who are still playing in the field; instead this is related to those eminent coaches of any particular sport.
- 15. Dhyan Chand Award** – The award that is given to the veteran sports persons of India for their lifetime

achievement in their respective field of sport is named as the Dhyan Chand Award for Life Time Achievement in **Sports and Games**.

**16. Rajiv Gandhi Khel Ratna Award** – The Rajiv Gandhi Khel Ratna is the highest honour bestowed to a sports person for his/her achievements in India.

**17. Stirling Prize – Architecture**

The Royal Institute of British Architects Stirling Prize is a British prize for excellence in architecture.

**18. Aga Khan Award – Architecture**

The Aga Khan Award for Architecture (AKAA) is an architectural prize established by Aga Khan IV in 1977. It aims to identify and reward architectural concepts that successfully address the needs and aspirations of Islamic societies in the fields of contemporary design, social housing, community development and improvement.

**19. Pritzker Prize – Architecture**

The Pritzker Architecture Prize is awarded annually “to honor a living architect.

**20. Shanti Swarup Bhatnagar Prize – Science & Technology**

The Shanti Swarup Bhatnagar Prize for Science and Technology (SSB) is a science award in India given annually by the Council of Scientific and Industrial Research (CSIR) for notable and outstanding research, applied or fundamental, in biology, chemistry, environmental science, engineering, mathematics, medicine and Physics.

**21. Kalinga Prize – Science**

The Kalinga Prize for the Popularization of Science is an award given by UNESCO for exceptional skill in presenting scientific ideas to lay people.

**22. Grammy Award – Music**

A Grammy Award, or Grammy, is an accolade by the National Academy of Recording Arts and Sciences of the United States to recognize outstanding achievement in the music industry.

**23. Abel Prize – Mathematics**

The Abel Prize is an international prize awarded annually by the Government of Norway to one or more outstanding mathematicians.

**24. International Gandhi Peace Prize** – This award is given to individuals and institutions for their contributions towards **social, economic and political revolution through non-violence and Gandhian philosophy**. The award carries Rs. 10 million in cash.

**25. Lal Bahadur Shastri National Award** – This is for Excellence in **Public Administration, Academics and Management**.

**26. Green Star Awards** – The Green Star Awards recognize those who have made extraordinary efforts to respond to **environmental disasters** around the world.

**27. Magsaysay Award** – **Public Service, Leadership, Journalism, Literature, creative arts and international understanding**.

**28. Pulitzer Prize** – The Pulitzer Prize is an award for achievements in **newspaper and online journalism, literature, and musical composition** in the United States.

**29. Sahitya Akademi Award** – **Books in Indian Languages and English**.

**30. Manthan Award** – It is an initiative in India to recognize the best practices in **e-Content and Creativity**.

**31. FiFi Awards** – The FiFi Awards honor the fragrance **industry’s creative achievements**.

Let’s come to water scarcity. Water scarcity means the unavailability of water is sufficient quality and quantity for drinking, cleaning and other uses in an area. Water is very important resource in nature, every organism need water for their survival. Water scarcity is also a major problem in India Ex. Bhundhelkhand drought kill many people. Now the question is what we can do to prevent water scarcity? We can do many things to prevent water scarcity for example:

Rain harvesting plant should be made on the roof of every house as there was in Kerala. In Kerala it was mandatory for every house to have rainwater harvesting plant. This rainwater is then stored in underground tanks and then used for washing, cleaning and other domestic purposes.

Second, industries are also the main cause of water pollution which results in water scarcity. Every industry has to supply their water to water treatment plant to remove the harmful waste in the water then it can be injected in the rivers.

Third, overexploitation of water is also a major cause of water scarcity. Farmers exploit groundwater recklessly to grow more and more crops by using tube wells, pumps etc. To prevent this government should supply water to villagers to prevent the misuse and overuse of water.

Now come to traffic congestion. Traffic congestion is a condition on transport networks that occurs as use increases, and is characterized by slower speeds, longer trip times, and increased vehicular use. It also creates air pollution and noise pollution on roads. We can stop this by the following measures:

- Educating the peoples to prevent careless driving on roads because peoples did not have driving sense in them which cause jams and blockage on roads.
- Perfect red lights can be installed to make a systematic control on traffic.
- People can use public transport instead of using their own vehicles.
- Wide roads-four lanes with footpath can be made to prevent traffic congestion on roads.

Last but not the least lets shift to Food Safety. Food safety means handling, preparation, and storage of food in order to prevent food borne illness and diseases. Food safety can be done by

- Making government food storage to store food in good conditions.
- Spreading awareness among the people about food safety.
- We should keep our kitchen and surrounding clean.

## BLACK MONEY

In India, black money refers to funds earned in the black market, on which income and other taxes have not been paid. The total amount of black money deposited in foreign banks by Indian is unknown. Some reports claim a total of US\$ 1.06 trillion is held illegally in Switzerland.

In February 2012, the director of India's central bureau of investigation said that Indians have us \$600 billion illegal funds in foreign tax havens, more than any other country. In March 2012, the government of India clarified in its parliament that the CBI director's statement on \$500 billion of illegal money was an estimate based on a statement made to India's supreme court of July 2011.

In a television address on 8 November 2016 by Indian Prime Minister Narendra Modi announced that bank notes of Rs. 500 and Rs. 1000 would cease to be legal tender from midnight. Automatic teller machines at some places were closed on 9 and 10 November.

Government organisations are expected to bring out new notes within a month. The government of India has accepted the proposal of RBI in bringing out Rs. 2000 bank notes and a new version of Rs. 500.

The old notes are being removed from circulation.

Factors for generation of black money include (i) high rate of taxation under direct taxes which encourages tax evasion, (ii) controls, permits and license, (iii) price control without adequate machinery for effective distribution (iv) puree and hawala systems, (v) donations to political parties for elections (vi) corrupt business practices, (vii) smuggling and other illegal anti-social activities


## भ्रष्टाचार

## Discover the Secrets to a long life .....live healthy

Ageing occurs when cells are permanently damaged by attacks of free radicals. They are formed daily through normal body processes, when the body eliminates toxins or fights diseases. These free radicals, thus formed, are unstable and highly reactive. They can cause severe damage to the cell structure, which can potentially induce cancer, heart disease, inflammation in the arthritic joints, brain degeneration and also hasten ageing process. According to research scientists, about 80% to 90% of all degenerative diseases involve free radical activity.

Ageing'. If one can kill the free radical or diffuse their activity, we can slow down the ageing process. Chemically, free radicals are molecules that have a missing electron. Since free radicals are highly reactive and unstable, they seek our another electron to pair up with in order to turn stable. It thus causes further damage to the existing normal cells. These free radicals can be neutralised by antioxidants compounds that can give one of their electrons.

Antioxidants are formed in fruits and vegetables. They are designed to diffuse the destructive free radicals. They stop the formation of free radicals, snuff them out and repair the damage. The top anti-ageing antioxidants are vitamin C, vitamin E and beta-carotene, others include selenium, chromium, zinc, calcium, etc.

As we grow older, the number of free radicals in our bodies increases. Also, the ability to neutralise the free radical decreases. Therefore take supplements and vitamins after age of 40. Stress also adds to damage. Stress chemicals affect the fat sugar metabolism, and interfere with the energy storage and energy expenditure affecting you weight. Eat antioxidants-rich foods such as carrots, lettuces and oranges to combat Stress. Cut down on refined processed and junk foods, and eat more natural foods.

### **CAN ANIMALS PREDICT DISASTER?**

Animals can sense impending danger by detecting subtle or abrupt shift in the environment. Some animals are able to sense infrasound produced by natural phenomena including earthquakes, tsunami, volcano and storm that are inaudible to human ear. Elephants could easily pick up vibrations generated from massive earthquake, tsunami. This ability may give elephants and other animals enough time to react and flee away.

- Many animals escaped the great Asian Tsunami on 26 Dec., 2004. Both wild and domestic animals fled to safe places.
- **Elephants** in Srilanka and Sumatra moved to higher ground before the giant waves struck; they did same in Thailand, trumpeting before they did so. Wildlife officials in Srilanka reported that no elephants died.
- According to a villager in Thailand, a herd of **Buffalo** were grazing by the beach when they “suddenly lifted their heads and looked out to sea, ears standing upright”. They turned and stampeded up the hills, whose lives were thereby saved.
- Many **Dogs** were howling for hours before the event ran up to the hill tops, and many dog owners were puzzled by the fact that the animals refused to go for their usual morning walk to the beach where they were usually excited to go.
- **Flamingos**, that breed this time of the year (Dec.) at Point Calimere Wildlife Sanctuary also flew to higher grounds beforehand.
